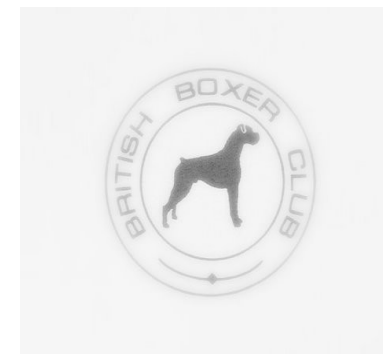

Definitions of Obedience Classes

Pre Beginner To compete in Pre Beginners a handler or dog must not have won a First Prize in either Pre Beginners or Beginners nor gained a third place or above in any other Obedience Classes.

Beginner For dog or Handler not having one two or more first prizes in Beginner, or one first in any other Obedience Class (Pre Beginner excepted)

Novice For dogs which have not won two First Prizes in Obedience Classes (Pre Beginners and Beginners excepted).

Class A For dogs which have not won three First Prizes in Class A, B and Open Class C in total

Dogs in Cars on Hot Days

Show Schedule Notice

Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and the Kennel Club offers the following guidance to help guide you through the do's and don'ts travelling to and whilst at KC licensed events.

When travelling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy holiday route, and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams.

If your vehicle is not air-conditioned seriously consider whether travelling to the show is a good idea at all.

The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible, and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of water available to drink.

Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog.

When at the show, never leave your dog in the vehicle.

Keep the dog in the shade – take your own shade for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water available to drink so your dog stays well hydrated.

Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion, or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time. Remember, if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare.

Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all

reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.

Introduction

Not only are many dogs expected to live in cities and densely populated housing situations, but the social climate has changed in recent years and there is a significant anti-dog lobby. Life is very stressful for our dogs!.

More than ever, dogs are required to behave in controlled and discriminating ways which may be at odds with behaviour characteristics of the individual breed or, indeed, of the species. For this reason owners need to know how their dog will behave in specific or general situations and when they are stressed. By evaluating their dog's tendency to respond in certain ways, an owner can be prepared for the future and can obtain additional training or socialisation, if necessary, to ensure their dog is safe.

The aim of the testing procedure is to make the tests as simple and as much like real-life situations as possible, so that owners have a good overview of their dogs. Test should be fun and include elements of everyday life which a dog is likely to encounter (such as traffic, unfamiliar people, other dogs, children, etc.)

This is not a test of training or of handling skills, but simply of how each dog is likely to re-act in certain circumstances. The scoring system is based upon a combination of the required characteristics of the Breed and a "reasonable response" by any dog. In order to interpret the observed behaviour of the dog, the examiner would like some background information on each dog. Please see attached Form to be completed and returned.

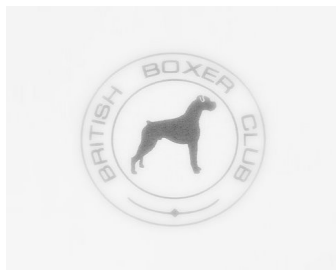

Instructions. This Form must be used by only one person or partnership. Writing must be in BLOCK LETTERS and in ink. Use a separate line for each dog. The name and exact details, as recorded at the Kennel Club must be given on the Entry Form. If an error is made, the dog may be disqualified by the Kennel Club. All dogs must be registered at the Kennel Club in the name of the exhibitor. If the registration of transfer of ownership has not been confirmed it must be applied for before the closing date of entries. In case of dispute, proof of postage of such application may be required by The Kennel Club. Puppies under six calendar months of age cannot be entered for competition. On no account will entries be accepted without fees. If a dog is in the process of Registration of Transfer at the time entry is made, add the letters NAF or TAF as appropriate after its name. Please put classes in numerical order. PLEASE CHECK ALL DETAILS BEFORE POSTING

Overseas exhibitors only: The Kennel Club Authority to compete number for dogs resident outside the UK MUST be stated or the Entry Form will be returned.
